[Curbside](#). The Spring 2018 curbside collection event will start Monday, April 16th (for single-family residents ONLY). You do not need to contact us to arrange a collection. Place up to two bulky items OR four containers of excess trash OR two bundles of yard waste at the curb by 6:00 A.M., Monday, April 16th. Our crews will make one pass through the City during the week collecting these items. This is a FREE event.

[Drop Off](#). If you prefer to drop off bulky items or trash, you may do so at the Palm Springs City Hall parking lot, 3200 E. Tahquitz Canyon Way. Drop-offs will be accepted on Saturday, April 21st ONLY, 8 A.M. to 2 P.M. (*Waste from commercial landscapers and contractors is NOT accepted. This is a FREE event for Palm Springs residents.*)
